Subscription

The first month of the subscription is a free trial period, the subscription can then be terminated free of charge with immediate effect.

System requirements

Prices

All rates stated are exclusive of VAT and are subject to price changes. Pefa retains the right to alter the rates on a unilateral basis. All Pefa invoices have payment terms of 15 days. The costs are invoiced annually in advance.

Direct debit
